

## COVID-19 Scenarios

### Regent has a query about possible case

1. If Regent has a query about a possible case where a pupil or teacher/coach has been confirmed with COVID-19, or who has been in close contact with someone who is confirmed with COVID-19, the Covid Officer will contact the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) for advice on 1300 651 160
2. DHHS will provide any additional specific advice based on their assessment of the particular circumstance
3. If the teacher/coach or pupil is a member of Calisthenics Victoria, CaliVic will be advised

### Regent has a confirmed case

1. If Regent becomes aware of a pupil or teacher/coach who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the Covid Officer will inform DHHS immediately
2. DHHS will provide additional specific advice based on their assessment of the particular circumstances.
3. If the teacher/coach or pupil is a member of Calisthenics Victoria, CaliVic will be advised

### DHHS aware of case involving Regent

1. If DHHS becomes aware of a pupil or teacher/coach who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the decision about whether to inform Regent and any members of the community will be made case by case in the interests of public health.
2. DHHS will provide any additional specific advice based on their assessment of the particular circumstances.
3. If the teacher/coach or pupil is a member of Calisthenics Victoria, CaliVic will be advised
4. Should Calisthenics Victoria be contacted prior to the Regent, Calisthenics Victoria will provide that advice to Re-Atrix.

## Suggested Protocols

### Testing

1. If Regent become aware of any test of pupil or teacher/coach due to being a suspected case, they should contact the DHHS
2. Unless advised by DHHS, Regent should not advise their community of any testing being undertaken or reports of suspected cases.

### Self-Isolation

1. DHHS advice is that pupils or teachers/coaches should self-isolate from the Club if the following applies:
  - a. The person is a confirmed case of COVID-19
  - b. The person is a close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days
2. This advice will take the form of a directive to Regent from the Victorian Government Chief Health Officer.

### Closure

1. Where a pupil or teacher/coach is confirmed with COVID-19, DHHS may advise that Regent be closed for 24 hours to enable contact tracing to occur.
2. This advice will take the form of a directive to Regent from DHHS. Regent should inform Calisthenics Victoria immediately if the person involved is a member.
3. Regent will inform their performers, coaches and families through their usual communication channels.
4. During the closure period, DHHS will advise whether the closure period needs to be extended and will work with Regent regarding the timing of re-opening of the venue.
